WHAT: Building Work at 133 E. Davis Street

WHEN: Beginning May 24, 2017 and lasting for approximately 3 weeks

WHERE: 133. E. Davis Street, E. Davis Street and S. Spring Street closings

## COMMENTS:

The southbound through lane of E. Davis Street approaching S. Spring Street will be closed beginning May 24, 2017. During this time, all traffic will be diverted into the left turn lane. This lane closure will take place intermittently for the next three weeks, and will only be closed between the hours of 9:00 am and 4:00 pm. All lane closures will be signed accordingly.

The westbound through lane of S. Spring Street from E. Davis Street to Maple Avenue will be closed beginning on or about May 31, 2017. During this time, all westbound traffic will be detoured to Lexington Avenue. Vehicles traveling eastbound in this block will be allowed to travel as normal. This closing will be intermittently for the next three weeks, and will only be closed between the hours of 9:00 am and 4:00 pm. All lane closures will be signed accordingly.

These lane closures will take place to facilitate building façade repair at 133. E. Davis Street. Sidewalks in these work areas will also be closed to pedestrian traffic and will be signed accordingly.
