Burlington, NC –Local elections are scheduled to take place across Alamance County on November 7. In an effort to reduce impediments to voting, the Burlington City Council has waived Link Transit fares all day on November 7th. Link Transit will operate regular routes on its regular schedule (5:30am-6:30pm). Free fares will be available on all routes for the whole day of Link Transit service on November 7.
